Code of Conduct

Bexhill Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. It is committed to everyone having the right to enjoy cricket free from the threat of intimidation, harassment and abuse.

The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, officials, guests and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore anyone associated with the club is encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Chairman John Malone or the Child Welfare Officer Janet Graves.

Bexhill Cricket Club Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians

The club is greatly appreciative for the contribution that parents and guardians make to Bexhill Cricket Club. We in turn hope that parents/guardians will undertake the following:

- 1 Remember that children play cricket for their own enjoyment and not yours.
- 2 Encourage children to participate and not to force them.
- 3 Focus on the efforts of each youth and their performance rather than whether they win, lose or make mistakes.
- 4 Encourage all youths to play cricket in accordance with the laws of the game remembering etiquette and Bexhill Cricket Club's Code of Conduct for youths.
- 5 Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials and opponents.
- 6 Parents/guardians must respect all officials' decisions and encourage their children to do likewise.
- 7 Set a good example by encouraging fair play and applauding good performances for all players whether they represent Bexhill Cricket Club or not.
- 8 Support all efforts to remove verbal abuse and dissent from cricket.
- 9 Provide the club/coach/team manager/official with details of any illness, allergies or injury and any situation where medication should be taken.
- 10 Supervise any other family members or friends of their children and family whilst at an organised match or coaching session.
- 11 Support the coach or team manager in any way that they can.

Bexhill Cricket Club Policy for Youths

It has been agreed that Bexhill Cricket Club will:

- 1 Ensure that all youths are given equal opportunities regardless of gender, ethnicity, disability or social status.
- 2 Safeguard the wellbeing of all youths.
- 3 Ensure that youths, their parents/guardians, coaches and team managers know that they are expected at all times to show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.
- 4 Ensure that youths, their parents, the coaches and team managers are encouraged to be open at all times and share their concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the Chairman John Malone or the Child Welfare Officer Janet Graves.
- 5 Ensure that fixtures are properly arranged and that a match manager is available for each game.
- 6 Ensure that all matches hosted by Bexhill Cricket Club are played on suitable surfaces and with safe facilities.
- 7 Ensure that training/coaching is where possible provided by ECB qualified coaches.
- 8 Ensure the suitability of coaches, team managers, organisers and volunteers.
- 9 Ensure that all coaches, team managers, organisers and volunteers are aware of and briefed as to Bexhill Cricket Clubs Code of Conduct for youths.
- 10 Ensure that there is no unsupervised use of the Bexhill Cricket Club bowling machine by a youth.
- 11 Ensure that First Aid kits are easily available and identifiable to all at the clubs home grounds and that all coaches, team managers, organisers and volunteers are aware of their location.
- 12 Ensure that youths wear a protective helmet when required to do so.
- 13 Ensure that no youth bowls more than their permitted maximum overs for their age group as recommended by the ECB.
- 14 Take all possible steps to supervise the taking of any prescribed medication in accordance with the requests of the youths.
- 15 Deal with an emergency concerning the health or welfare of a youth.
- 16 Carry adequate levels of insurance for Public Liability insurance cover.

The following standards are expected from all Bexhill Cricket Club's youths

- 1 Matches will be played competitively and with full commitment.
- 2 The opposition should be respected and treated in a sportsmanlike manner.
- 3 The umpires decision must be respected at all times and dissent should never be shown.
- 4 Behaviour at any match wherever played must not cause offence to any person and all local rules must be obeyed.
- 5 It is unacceptable to intimidate or deliberately distract opponents orally or by acts of gamesmanship and aggressive behaviour.
- 6 Foul and/or abusive language is not acceptable at any time.
- 7 It is expected that all players will keep to timings for coaching or matches or inform their coach/team manager if they are going to be late.
- 8 It is unacceptable for any player to smoke, drink alcohol or take drugs whilst participating in a match or organised coaching session.
- 9 It is expected that all players will dress in smart clothing whilst playing in a match as agreed with the coach or team manager.

Code of Conduct for Members and Guests

All members and guests of Bexhill Cricket Club are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

All members must play within the rules of the game and respect the officials and their decisions. All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background, age, sexuality, social/economic status or religion and treat everyone equally within the context of cricket. Not condone or allow to go unchallenged any form of discrimination if witnessed. Display high standards of behaviour at all times. Promote all positive aspects of cricket including fair play. Encourage all participants to learn the laws and rules and play within them. Actively discourage unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials. Recognise good performance not solely based on match results. Place the well being and safety of young people above the development of performance. Ensure that activities are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of the individual. Respect young people's opinions when making decisions about their participation in cricket. Not smoke, drink or use banned substances whilst actively working with young people in the club. Not provide young people with alcohol whilst they are under the care of the club. Follow ECB Guidelines set out in the "Safe Hands – Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children" and any other relevant guidelines issued. Report any concerns in relation to a young person following procedures laid down by the ECB.

Members and Guests include all members and officers of the Cricket Club and all guests of those members and officers, as well as all individuals who watch / attend / participate / officiate in matches hosted by the club in whatever capacity.

Please note that this form must be completed by all members and returned to the Junior Co-ordinator and that by returning a signed form you are agreeing to abide by the Club's Constitutional Rules and implemented policies including Codes of Conduct for Players, Junior Members, Parents, Coaches and Guests of the club, as detailed above and overleaf.

Parents/Guardians of children automatically become members of Bexhill Cricket Club once their children are fully paid up club members.

All players are reminded that they play at their own risk and parents/guardians should arrange individual personal accident insurance if felt appropriate. Players signing this form are acknowledging that they have read and understood this policy. It is your responsibility to provide all protective equipment for your child although Bexhill Cricket Club does have small stock of some items. Please contact your child's Team Manager for further details.
