“ECB”	-	England and Wales Cricket Board
“Parents”	-	also should be read as parents, carer(s), legal guardian(s)

We hold it to be self-evident that the Youths/Colts are more likely to enjoy their cricket and have more fun if they are part of a well managed structure with access to top quality coaching in a safe environment.
